Fishing Regulations

- All fishing **MUST** terminate ½ hour before closing time.
- For safety reasons, children 15 and under **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.
- **Be a citizen scientist!** Please report any fish caught to the front desk.
- Adult fishing is 'catch and release'. Children under 12 may keep a limit of 1 fish.
- Fishing is FREE for members of FortWhyte Alive.
- The fee for non-members is admission plus fishing fee.
- Live bait is permitted.
- All hooks must be barbless.
- No personal watercraft.
- The dikes between the lakes are closed to fishing after mid-September.
- No fishing allowed in wetlands, including swamps, marshes and boardwalks.
- No fishing allowed on sailing dock.
- All persons 16 and over must carry a valid Manitoba fishing license. Manitoba angling regulations apply.
- **DO NOT LITTER.** Discarded fishing line is an extreme hazard to all wildlife. Garbage bins are located throughout FWA.
- **VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN SUSPENSION OF FISHING PRIVILEGES.**
