Atlatl

Before guns, or even bows and arrows, Indigenous people relied on the atlatl to hunt bison. This spear thrower enabled hunters to throw much farther and harder than if they were relying only on their own strength. Try your hand at this traditional hunting method and see how much force you can muster!

Canadian Prairie Past

Take a step back to a time when bison roamed the prairie, and people's connection to the natural world was a matter of survival. Visit our Pioneer Sod House built from the earth, then stop by the Bison Viewing Mound and discover the importance of this prairie giant to the Plains Cree. Explore the culture of the Métis, the influence they had on the fur trade, and their connection to the buffalo hunt.

Golf Cart Cruise


