#### BANNOCK BAR!

#### ATLATL

Before guns, or even bows and arrows, Indigenous people around the world relied on the atlatl to hunt. This spear thrower enabled hunters to throw much farther and harder than if they were relying only on their own strength. Try your hand at this traditional hunting method.

#### HATCHET THROWING

Cut loose and split some stumps as you hone your frontier skills in a laid-back atmosphere. If you're looking for a sharp team-building idea, hatchet-throwing is right on target!

#### CANADIAN PRAIRIE PAST 🚯 🚯

Take a step back to a time when bison roamed the prairie and people's connection to the natural world was a matter of survival. Visit our Homesteader Sod House built from the earth, then stop by the Bison Viewing Mound and discover the importance of this prairie giant to Indigenous People. Explore the culture of the Métis, the influence they had on the fur trade, and their connection to the buffalo hunt.

#### **GPS GEOCACHING**

Challenge your group to a high-tech, geocaching treasure hunt. Your team will be equipped with a GPS unit programmed with target coordinates to lead you to your caches. Collect all the clues to complete the puzzle!

A great option if you want to stay indoors, more than out, and as a backup should the weather turn on you during your day at FortWhyte. We will make you think, make you laugh, and get you out of your seats. Side games give individuals a chance to shine, and teamwork is required for the main quiz.

#### WINNIPEG'S WILD WONDERFUL WEATHER (NEW)

Weather is important to everyone, everywhere, but life in Winnipeg can be defined by the sky. Head outside to measure current conditions using the same instruments the pros use to predict the next 72 hours. Check out climate adaptations of plants and wildlife, and learn how a changing atmosphere is having an impact in Winnipeg, and from south to north in Manitoba.

Finish up inside and be regaled with tales of major weather events in Winnipeg's past. When was the biggest blizzard? Why does a prairie city boast one of the world's biggest canals?

Embrace winter and the fur trade history of the Red River Valley as you race through the forests, prairies, and frozen ponds of FortWhyte Alive! Navigate the winter landscape, crunch over drifts with snowshoes, and test your strength and teamwork with traditional games, hatchet throwing, and more.

Each team will be given a "klondike sled" (a human-pulled dogsled) loaded with equipment. A FortWhyte facilitator will guide the team down our trails, stopping for activities along the way. Each activity will be worth points (awarded for team effort, skill, speed, etc.) or "furs". Teams compete to see who can bring the most furs into the trading post at the end.
